After extensive discussion, North Dalton Parish Council reached an impasse, with a 50/50 split on the application. Concerns were raised regarding the use of non-traditional materials, particularly the windows, and whether they would preserve the village's aesthetic character. On the other hand, it was noted that while the windows are not made of wood, they are designed to closely resemble traditional wooden windows. The Council also carefully considered the comments from the Conservation Officer and acknowledged their concerns. As the final vote resulted in a 50/50 split, no formal decision was made, and the Council has agreed to submit a neutral comment.
