Concerns were raised over the quantity of signs around the village at present providing a distraction to the drivers without adding additional speed indicator devices as well, other members also raised concerns over there not being traffic concerns within the village whilst other members raised huge concerns.

A resident reached out to the council for assistance with the bus service, not accommodating a school pickup closer to their home, leaving a young person walking to and from the village, where there is no dedicated walkway or lighting, Clerk requested resident share some additional details via email for us to investigate options.

Applicant of the caravan club planning also spoke to advise the council that the application had not been submitted or taken any further at present but could not confirm if this will be indefinite.
