

**MINUTES TO THE MEETING OF NORTH DALTON PARISH COUNCIL

722. Received Apologies: Apologies were received from Cllr T Byass, I Hare

723. Received Declaration Interest: No declarations of interest were made.

724. Agreed to open the meeting to:

It was agreed to open the meeting to Ward Councillor Leo Hammond and two members of the public.

Cllr Leo Hammond answered questions from both councillors and members of the public regarding the device. As Cllr Hammond also represents the Police and Crime Commissioner in relation to the Auto Speed Watch Scheme, he was able to provide further detail regarding the operational aspects of the device.

725. Auto Speed Watch Scheme – Review of Previously Approved Resolution

The Council reviewed the grant agreement, financial implications, proposed location, operational considerations, and additional feedback received from other parish councils already operating the device.

Concerns raised regarding the grant agreement and the implications of the long-term commitment to the device were eased following clarification from the PCC that alternative arrangements could be considered should the Council decide not to continue for the full term. The Clerk confirmed that sufficient funds are available to cover the ongoing annual licence costs.

Following discussion, all members agreed with the proposed changes and actions required to move forward.

Clerk Actions:

- Update the proposed location of the device with ERYC.
- Amended location now means the device can be fitted directly to a lighting column, reducing the additional cost of installing a separate post.
- Update the grant agreement to reflect the revised costs from ERYC, including the addition of the device booster as recommended by another parish council already operating the devices.
- Once the location has been updated, provide the revised details to the PCC and complete the grant agreement.
- Proceed with the purchase of the equipment.
- Arrange for ERYC to complete their part of the installation.
- Provide copies of the invoices to the PCC to reclaim the 50% grant funding.

Total Estimated cost £1,241.00 (50% to be covered by the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) Grant Funding)
